The “Heavy Trash” company is not allowed to come onto residents’ property. You may begin bringing your heavy trash to the curb as soon as you are able to start.

The following may NOT be set out for collection:

- Paint and paint related materials
- Kitchen and bathroom cleaning solvents
- Automotive products (used oil, antifreeze)
- Flammable materials
- Household trash (that is collected on regular trash day)
- Chemicals
- Oil or gasoline in cans
- Tires
- Limbs or brush
- Heavy trash or concrete pieces too heavy for 2 men hand loading
- Refrigerators
- Tubed TVs

Items that will be collected are:

- Yard junk
- Construction junk
- Attic junk
- Old computers
- Appliances/furniture

NO LIMBS OR BRUSH WILL BE PICKED UP.

These services are limited to only the residents in the City Limits of Thompsons.
