

**TOWN OF THOMPSONS  
CITY COUNCIL  
5/12/26**

The Town Council of Thompsons, Texas, met in Special Session in the Council Chamber located at 520 Oilfield Road at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, with Mayor Freddie Newsome, Jr. presiding. Council members present were Edward E. Taylor, James Todd, Gina Treadgold, Nathan Walleck and Gary Mosier.

At this special meeting, the first item to discuss, was to canvass the votes from the May 2, 2026, General Election, for Two (2) Aldermen. The canvass was done by Mayor Freddie Newsome, Jr. The number of registered voters was 143. The total number of votes cast was 28. There were three candidates for Aldermen: Lorene Spears received 4 votes, Gary Mosier received 10 votes and Edward E. Taylor received 14 votes. On a motion from Gina Treadgold, seconded by Edward E. Taylor, the two (2) Aldermen elected for the Town of Thompsons are: Gary Mosier and Edward E. Taylor.

The other item on the ballot was Proposition A. This was "The adoption of a local sales and use tax in the Town of Thompsons at the rate of two (2) percent". There were 21 votes cast. There were fifteen for and six against. On a motion from Gina Treadgold, seconded by Edward E. Taylor, Proposition A passed.

The Mayor commented that the George Foundation was happy with the passing of Proposition A.

Under other business before the Council, Councilwoman Treadgold stated that 2 items need to be put on the Regular Agenda, scheduled for next week on May 21, 2026: the TextMyGov Proposal and the hiring of a Police Chief for the Town of Thompsons in a closed session.

Councilwoman Treadgold stated that Comcast is continuing with the internet installation to the residents of the Town of Thompsons.

Mayor stated that the Thompsons Volunteer Fire Department roof estimate will be discussed as well as the washing of the Thompsons City Hall/Community Center Building.


